

ENROLLMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM CORE OFFERINGS DURING NON-STANDARD TIMES

GOALS

- 1. Enhance classroom utilization during non-peak hours.**
- 2. Provide increased opportunities to complete general education core.**
- 3. Ease financial burden of attending college for beginning students.**
- 4. Attract non-traditional and previously enrolled students back to complete general education core.**
- 5. Increase Lamar University's graduation rate.**

PROGRAM

Give 20% local tuition reduction (not fees) on all general education core courses taken in 2009-10 Academic Year during the following two periods/times:

Period 11 (7-7:50 a.m. on MWF)

Period K (9-11:45 a.m. on Saturday)

That is, local tuition will be \$126 per semester hour rather than \$158 for core courses taken during Period 11 or Period K during the 2010-11 Academic Year.

INCENTIVES

- 1. If the core course is taught as an overload or by an adjunct, the stipend will be \$3,797.**
- 2. In addition, the home department will be given \$500 in a rollover account to use for faculty development (not salary) as long as the core course is in addition to regular offerings during the 2009-2010 baseline semesters.**
- 3. If the course is taught in-load, the instructor will be given a one-time payment of \$500, as long as the condition in #2 is satisfied.**

(Note: This program applies only to core courses offered on campus during Periods 11 and K.

There will be a limit of 8 on the number of sections offered under this program, and the standard enrollment guidelines relative to small classes will remain in effect. Final decisions on which of the submitted classes will be offered under this program will be made by the Provost, upon recommendation of the dean.)
